Younger than age 40 and have a family history of breast cancer	Breast cancer screening before age 40	Mammography
Age 40 or older	Breast cancer screening	Mammography
Younger than age 50 and have a family history of colorectal cancer	Colorectal cancer screening before age 50	Colonoscopy
Age 50 or older	Colorectal cancer screening	Fecal Occult Blood test (FOBT) Colonoscopy
